St Augustine's Catholic High School and Sixth Form has today been awarded the accolade of becoming a Behaviour Hub. These are the brainchild of Tom Bennett, who is the lead behaviour advisor to the Department for Education. Early last year he was appointed the Chair of a new task force created by the DfE to tackle unruly behaviour in schools. Over 1000 schools applied to the DfE to become a Behaviour Hub and today, 22 successful schools have been announced.

The award will enable St Augustine's which has an exemplary behaviour culture and practice in place, to work closely with partner schools to support and facilitate them in implementing systems and measures to improve the behaviour of their students in school.

Mr O'Connor, Principal of St Augustine's noted, "I am proud of our staff who have worked hard to earn this well-deserved distinction. Our Pastoral team are dedicated professionals who work tirelessly to ensure that our high expectations of behaviour are met by every student. We look forward to partnering with other schools to share our best practice and support them with their behavioural needs".
